Certain versions of [Shortcut Macros](#) from [Shortcut Macros Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Shortcut Macros WordPress plugin through 1.3 does not have authorisation and CSRF checks in place when updating its settings, which could allow any authenticated users, such as subscriber, to update them.

CVE-2022-1956 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
