

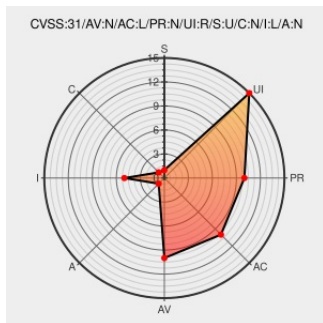

Certain versions of [Mycss](#) from [Mycss Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The MyCSS WordPress plugin through 1.1 does not have CSRF check in place when updating its settings, which could allow attackers to make a logged in admin change them via a CSRF attack

CVE-2022-1960 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown** - **MyCSS** version <= 1.1
