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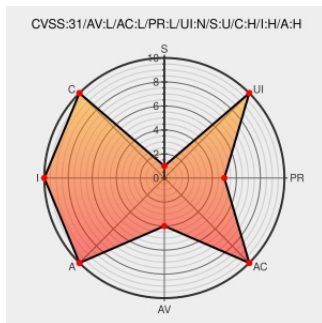

Certain versions of [Android](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In Settings, there is a possible way to connect to an open network bypassing DISALLOW_CONFIG_WIFI restriction due to a logic error in the code. This could lead to local escalation of privilege with no additional execution privileges needed. User interaction is not needed for exploitation. Product: Android Versions: Android-13 Android ID: A-227619193

CVE-2022-20248 has been assigned by security@android.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
