

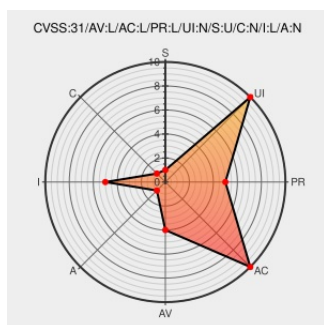

In bluetooth, there is a possible way to enable or disable bluetooth connection without user consent due to a missing permission check. This could lead to local escalation of privilege with User execution privileges needed. User interaction is not needed for exploitation. Product: Android Versions: Android-13 Android ID: A-
