

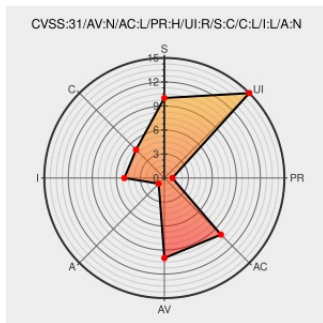

Certain versions of [Very Simple Breadcrumb](#) from [Very Simple Breadcrumb Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Very Simple Breadcrumb WordPress plugin through 1.0 does not sanitise and escape its settings, allowing high privilege users such as admin to perform Cross-Site Scripting attacks even when the `unfiltered_html` capability is disallowed.

CVE-2022-2149 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown - Very Simple Breadcrumb** version **<= 1.0**
