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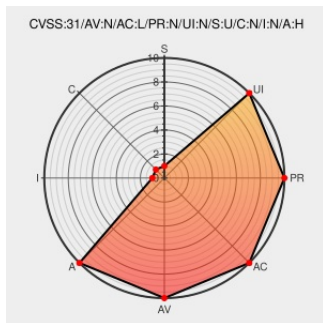

The HiAlserver has a vulnerability in verifying the validity of the weight used in the model. Successful exploitation of this vulnerability will affect AI services.
