

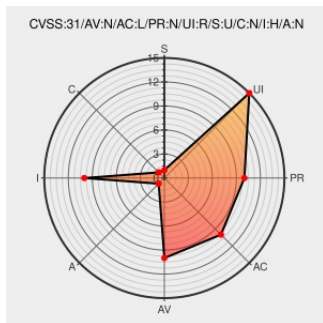

Certain versions of [Partner Engagement Manager](#) from [Ibm](#) contain the following vulnerability:

IBM Sterling Partner Engagement Manager 6.1.2, 6.2, and Cloud/SaaS 22.2 is vulnerable to cross-site request forgery which could allow an attacker to execute malicious and unauthorized actions transmitted from a user that the website trusts. IBM X-Force ID: 220652.

CVE-2022-22359 has been assigned by [psirt@us.ibm.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
