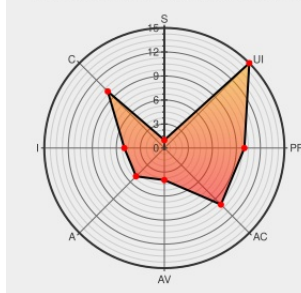

MobiSoft - MobiPlus User Take Over and Improper Handling of url Parameters Attacker can navigate to specific url which will expose all the users and password in clear text.
