Certain versions of [Petereport](#) from [Petereport Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

PeteReport Version 0.5 allows an authenticated admin user to inject persistent JavaScript code while adding an 'Attack Tree' by modifying the 'svg_file' parameter.

CVE-2022-23051 has been assigned by help@fluidattacks.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
