Certain versions of [Pterepore](#) from [Pterepore Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

PeteReport Version 0.5 allows an authenticated admin user to inject persistent JavaScript code inside the markdown descriptions while creating a product, report or finding.

CVE-2022-25220 has been assigned by help@fluidattacks.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
