

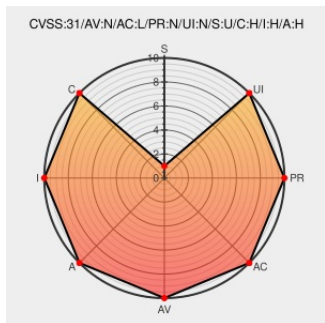

Certain versions of [Diaenergie](#) from [Deltaww](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Delta Electronics DIAEnergie (All versions prior to 1.8.02.004) is vulnerable to path traversal attacks, which may allow an attacker to write arbitrary files to locations on the file system.

CVE-2022-25347 has been assigned by [ics-cert@hq.dhs.gov](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
