

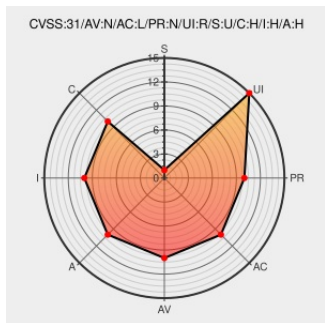

Certain versions of [Typesetter](#) from [Typesettercms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

TypesetterCMS v5.1 was discovered to contain a Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) which is exploited via a crafted POST request.

CVE-2022-25523 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
