

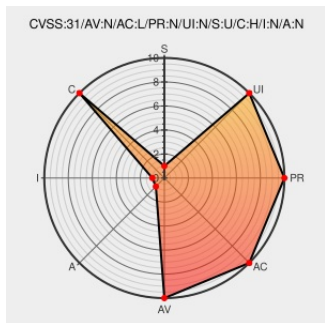

Certain versions of [Servst](#) from [Servst Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Versions of the package servst before 2.0.3 are vulnerable to Directory Traversal due to improper sanitization of the filePath variable.

CVE-2022-25936 has been assigned by report@snyk.io to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
