

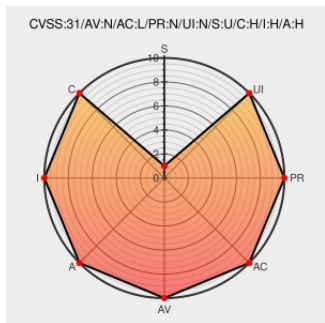


# CVE-2022-26285

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## CVE-2022-26285

Certain versions of [Simple Client Management System](#) from [Simple Client Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Simple Subscription Website v1.0 was discovered to contain a SQL injection vulnerability via the id parameter in the apply endpoint. This vulnerability allows attackers to dump the application's database via crafted HTTP requests.

CVE-2022-26285 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.

CVSS3 Score: **9.8 - CRITICAL**
