

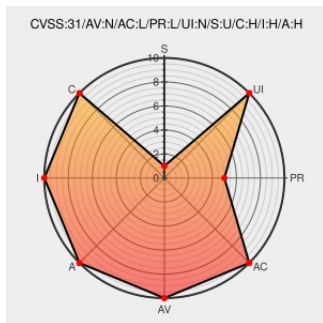

Jellycms v3.8.1 and below was discovered to contain an arbitrary file upload vulnerability via `\app\admin\Controllers\db.php`.
