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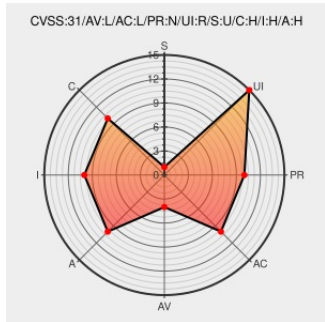

Certain versions of [Ipados](#) from [Apple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A memory corruption issue was addressed with improved state management. This issue is fixed in iOS 15.5 and iPadOS 15.5. An application may be able to execute arbitrary code with kernel privileges.

CVE-2022-26744 has been assigned by product-security@apple.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
