Certain versions of [Zbzcms](#) from [Zbzcms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An arbitrary file upload vulnerability at `/admin/ajax.php` in `zbzcms v1.0` allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted PHP file.

CVE-2022-27129 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
