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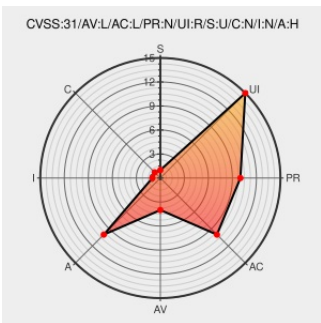

Certain versions of [Extra Packages For Enterprise Linux](#) from [Fedoraproject](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In ImageMagick, a crafted file could trigger an assertion failure when a call to WriteImages was made in MagickWand/operation.c, due to a NULL image list. This could potentially cause a denial of service. This was fixed in upstream ImageMagick version 7.1.0-30.

CVE-2022-2719 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
