Certain versions of [Extended Choice Parameter](#) from [Jenkins](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A missing permission check in Jenkins Extended Choice Parameter Plugin 346.vd87693c5a_86c and earlier allows attackers with Overall/Read permission to connect to an attacker-specified URL.

CVE-2022-27205 has been assigned by [jenkinsci-cert@googlegroups.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
