

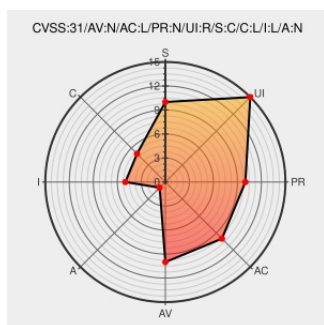

Certain versions of [Hubzilla](#) from [Hubzilla](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple Cross-Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerabilities in Hubzilla 7.0.3 and earlier allows remote attacker to include arbitrary web script or HTML via the rpath parameter.

CVE-2022-27258 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
