Certain versions of [Idccms](#) from [Idccms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

idcCMS v1.10 was discovered to contain an issue which allows attackers to arbitrarily delete the install.lock file, resulting in a reset of the CMS settings and data.

CVE-2022-27333 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
