

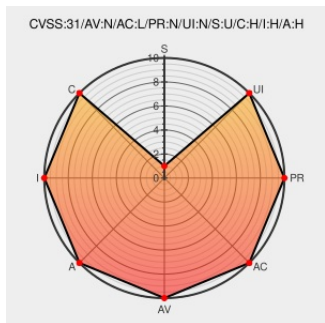

Certain versions of [Ecommerce-website](#) from [Ecommerce-website Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Ecommerce-Website v1 was discovered to contain an arbitrary file upload vulnerability via /customer_register.php. This vulnerability allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted PHP file.

CVE-2022-27357 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
