Certain versions of [Cynet 360](#) from [Cynet](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cynet 360 Web Portal before v4.5 was discovered to allow attackers to access a list of monitored files and profiles via a crafted GET request sent to `/WebApp/SettingsFileMonitor/GetFileMonitorProfiles`.

CVE-2022-27968 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
