

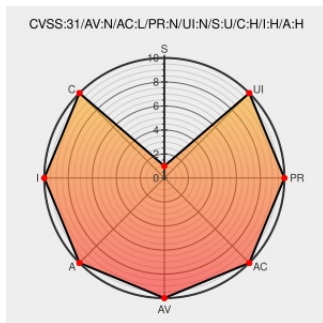

Certain versions of [Online Sports Complex Booking System](#) from [Online Sports Complex Booking System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SCBS Online Sports Venue Reservation System v1.0 was discovered to contain a local file inclusion vulnerability which allow attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted PHP file.

CVE-2022-28093 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
