

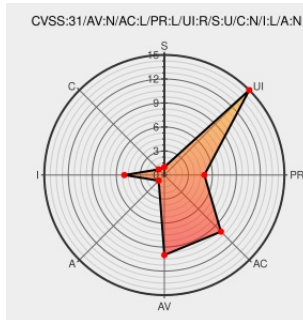

Certain versions of [Guest Management System](#) from [Guest Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability classified as problematic has been found in SourceCodester Guest Management System. This affects an unknown part of the file myform.php. The manipulation of the argument name leads to cross site scripting. It is possible to initiate the attack remotely.

The exploit has been disclosed to the public and may be used. The

identifier VDB-206397 was assigned to this vulnerability.

CVE-2022-2811 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
