

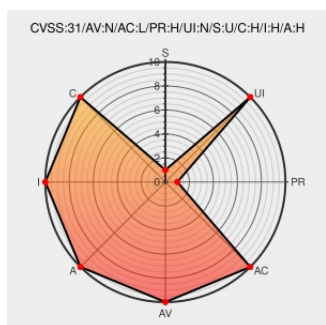

A Remote Code Execution (RCE) vulnerability exists in Pixelimity 1.0 via admin/admin-ajax.php?action=install_theme.
