

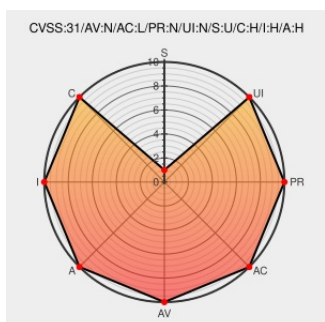

Certain versions of **N600r** from **Totolink** contain the following vulnerability:

TOTOLink N600R V5.3c.7159_B20190425 was discovered to contain a command injection vulnerability via the filename parameter in /setting/setUpgradeFW.

CVE-2022-28912 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
