

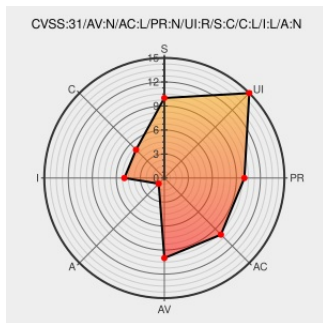

Certain versions of [E-diary Management System](#) from [E-diary Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Diary Management System v1.0 was discovered to contain a cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability via the Name parameter in search-result.php.

CVE-2022-29004 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
