Certain versions of [Directory Management System](#) from [Directory Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple SQL injection vulnerabilities via the username and password parameters in the Admin panel of Directory Management System v1.0 allows attackers to bypass authentication.

CVE-2022-29006 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
