Certain versions of [GraphQL-upload](#) from [GraphQL-upload Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An arbitrary file upload vulnerability in the file upload module of GraphQL-upload v13.0.0 allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted filename.

CVE-2022-29353 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
