

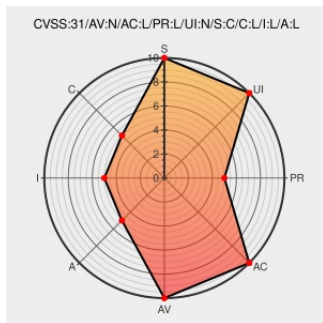

Certain versions of [Hermit](#) from [Hermit Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Authenticated SQL Injection (SQLi) vulnerability in Mufeng's Hermit 音乐播放器 plugin <= 3.1.6 on WordPress allows attackers with Subscriber or higher user roles to execute SQLi attack via (&ids).

CVE-2022-29410 has been assigned by [audit@patchstack.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
