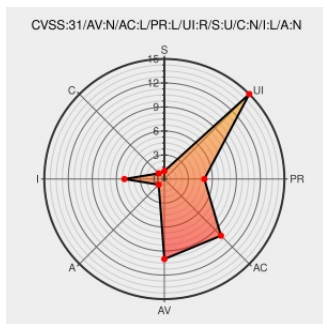

Certain versions of [Noxen](#) from [Noxen Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability classified as problematic has been found in ConsoleTVs Noxen. Affected is an unknown function of the file /Noxen-master/users.php. The manipulation of the argument create_user_username with the input "><script>alert(/xss/)</script>" leads to cross site scripting. It is possible to launch the attack remotely.

The exploit has been disclosed to the public and may be used. The identifier of this vulnerability is VDB-207000.

CVE-2022-2956 has been assigned by cna@vuldb.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
