

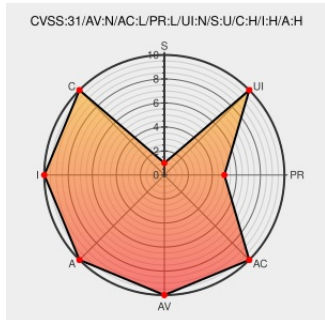

Certain versions of [Tpcms](#) from [Tpcms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An arbitrary file upload vulnerability in the Add File function of TPCMS v3.2 allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted PHP file.

CVE-2022-29624 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
