

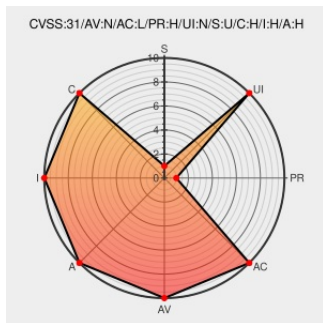

Certain versions of [Wedding Management System](#) from [Wedding Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An arbitrary file upload vulnerability in the Upload Photos module of Wedding Management System v1.0 allows attackers to execute arbitrary code via a crafted PHP file.

CVE-2022-29655 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
