

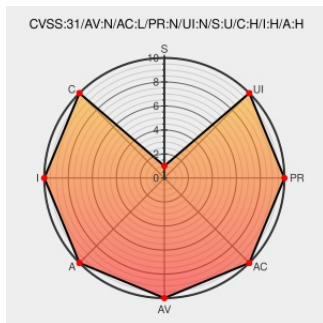

Certain versions of [lspy](#) from [lspyconnect](#) contain the following vulnerability:

iSpy v7.2.2.0 is vulnerable to remote command execution via path traversal.
