

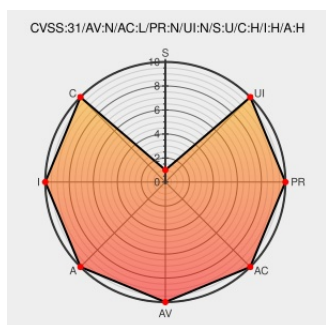

Certain versions of [Hospital Management System](#) from [Hospital Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In HMS 1.0 when requesting appointment.php through POST, multiple parameters can lead to a SQL injection vulnerability.

CVE-2022-30011 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
