

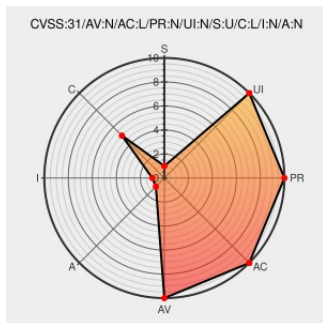

Shopwind <=v3.4.2 was discovered to contain a Arbitrary File Download vulnerability via the neirong parameter at `\backend\controllers\DbController.php`.
