

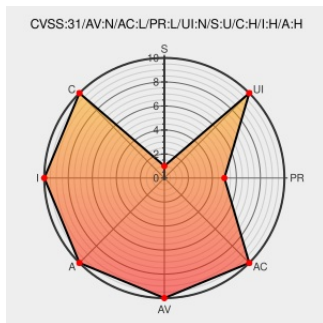

ftcms <=2.1 was discovered to be vulnerable to Arbitrary File Write via admin/controllers/tp.php
