

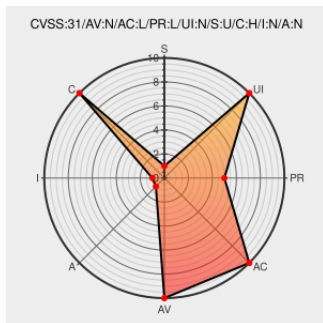

Certain versions of [Ftcms](#) from [Ftcms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

ftcms <=2.1 was discovered to be vulnerable to directory traversal attacks via the parameter tp.
