

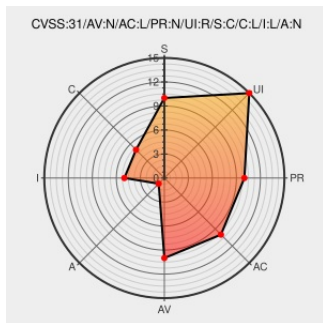

Certain versions of [Jquery Json-viewer](#) from [Jquery Json-viewer Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The jquery.json-viewer library through 1.4.0 for Node.js does not properly escape characters such as < in a JSON object, as demonstrated by a SCRIPT element.

CVE-2022-30241 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
