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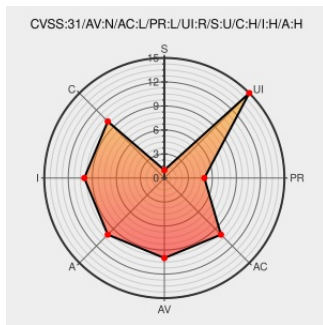

Certain versions of **Ebx** from **Tibco** contain the following vulnerability:

The Web Server component of TIBCO Software Inc.'s TIBCO EBX contains an easily exploitable vulnerability that allows a low privileged attacker with network access to execute Stored Cross Site Scripting (XSS) on the affected system. A successful attack using this vulnerability requires human interaction from a person other than the attacker. Affected releases are TIBCO Software Inc.'s TIBCO EBX:

versions 6.0.0 through 6.0.8.

CVE-2022-30577 has been assigned by security@tibco.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **TIBCO Software Inc. - TIBCO EBX** version <= 6.0.8
