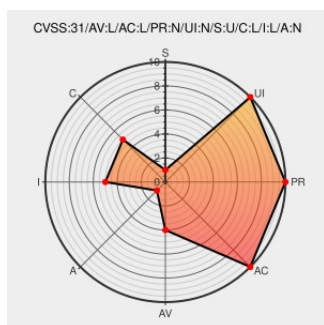

Improper access control vulnerability in My Files prior to version 13.1.00.193 allows attackers to access arbitrary private files in My Files application.
