

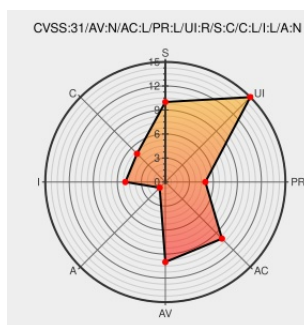

Certain versions of [Autocomplete Parameter](#) from [Jenkins](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Jenkins Autocomplete Parameter Plugin 1.1 and earlier does not escape the name of Dropdown Autocomplete and Auto Complete String parameters on views displaying parameters, resulting in a stored cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability exploitable by attackers with Item/Configure permission.

CVE-2022-30961 has been assigned by [jenkinsci-cert@googlegroups.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: [Jenkins project](#) - **Jenkins Autocomplete Parameter Plugin** version **not down converted**
