Description	NextAuth.js is a complete open source authentication solution for Next.js applications. An information disclosure vulnerability was discovered in the source code of NextAuth.js. The vulnerability allows an attacker to access sensitive information stored in the database. The vulnerability is located in the <code>next-auth.js</code> package, version 4.0.0-beta.0. The vulnerability is a result of a missing check for the <code>session</code> variable in the <code>getSession</code> function. The vulnerability is fixed in version 4.0.0-beta.1.
