

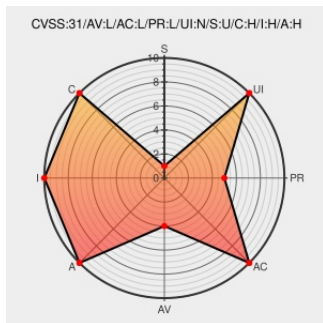

Certain versions of [Protect](#) from [Adaware](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Insecure permissions configuration in Adaware Protect v1.2.439.4251 allows attackers to escalate privileges via changing the service binary path.

CVE-2022-31464 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
