

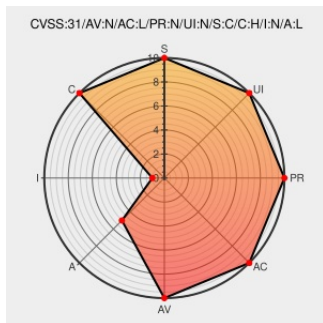

Certain versions of [Anakin](#) from [Paddlepaddle](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The PaddlePaddle/Anakin repository through 0.1.1 on GitHub allows absolute path traversal because the Flask send_file function is used unsafely.

CVE-2022-31523 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
