

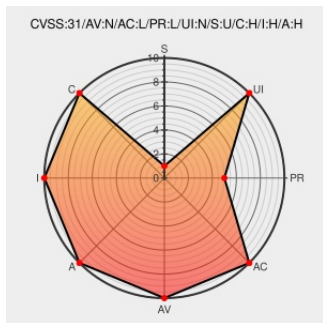

Certain versions of [Theme Park Ticketing System](#) from [Theme Park Ticketing System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Theme Park Ticketing System v1.0 was discovered to contain a SQL injection vulnerability via the id parameter at edit\_ticket.php.

CVE-2022-32302 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
