

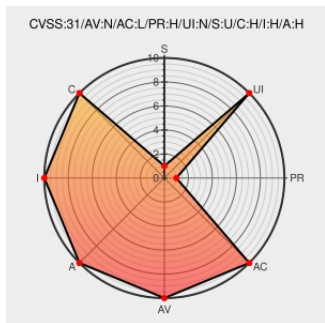

Certain versions of [Product Show Room Site](#) from [Product Show Room Site Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Product Show Room Site v1.0 is vulnerable to SQL Injection via `/psrs/admin/?page=products/manage_product&id=`.

CVE-2022-32364 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
