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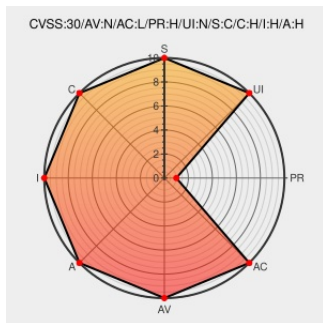

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Certain versions of **R1510** from **Robustel** contain the following vulnerability:

A command execution vulnerability exists in the clih art2 functionality of Robustel R1510 3.3.0. A specially-crafted network request can lead to arbitrary command execution. An attacker can send a sequence of requests to trigger this vulnerability.

CVE-2022-32585 has been assigned by talos-cna@cisco.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
