Certain versions of [Ca Automic Automation](#) from [Broadcom](#) contain the following vulnerability:

CA Automic Automation 12.2 and 12.3 contain an authentication error vulnerability in the Automic agent that could allow a remote attacker to potentially execute arbitrary commands.

CVE-2022-33750 has been assigned by vuln@ca.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
